This association with torpedoes, submarines and submariners has continued ever since.

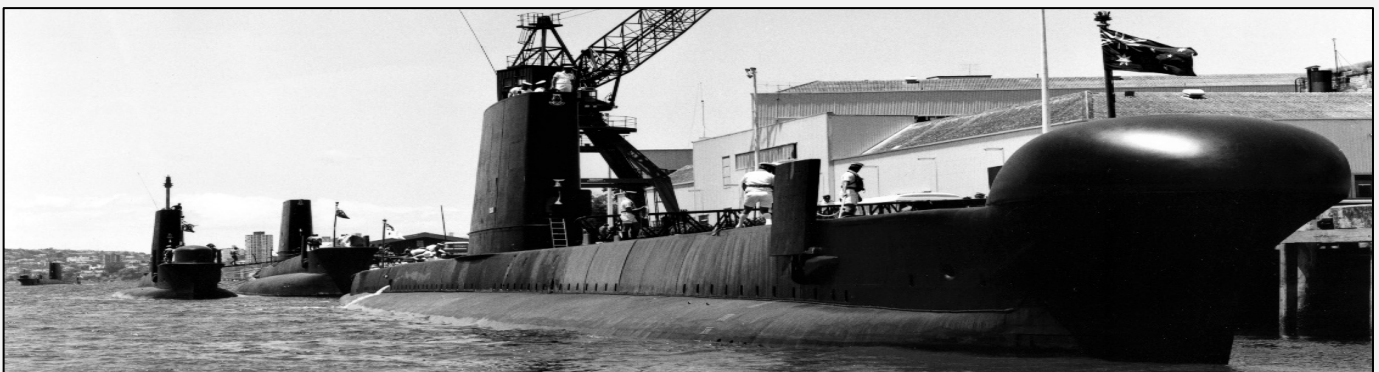
As Sydney Harbour was the only place in Australia to have ships attacked by submarines there is a story to tell.

### For Group Organisers

- The Naval Historical Society of Australia will conduct this tour for your group at a mutually agreed date and time.

- HMAS Platypus
- Torpedo Factory which operated on the Platypus site

**Location:** Sub Base Platypus, 120 High Street, North Sydney NSW 2060

**Duration:** 1.5 hours starting at 1030 am.

**Cost:** The cost is \$25 per head. Paid by bank transfer ahead of time or cheque on the day.

**Mobility:** Sub Base Platypus is on several levels. There are stairs & lifts. The tour will be on the flat to gently rising surfaces.
